INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS.

The Port Macquarie Club is an incorporated club affiliated with the Central Districts Rowing Association (CDRA) and thereby the New South Wales Rowing Association (NSWRA) and Rowing Australia.

The Club year runs from July to June of the next year.

The aim of the Club is to promote the skills and enjoyment of rowing for its members and within the community. Rowing is a sport that requires the individual to develop correct technique, teamwork, strength, endurance, boatmanship and friendship.

Membership fees are used to cover the costs of the general running and upkeep of the Club.

Club activities are carried out under the direction of the Club Captain and the Club committee or a sub committee. Craft are not to be used without the Club Captain's permission. Many craft in the shed are privately owned or are only to be used by particular crews. Accordingly, if you are new to the club you will need to seek advice as to the boats that are available to you to row.

Rowing clubs take great pride in their achievements, traditions and especially their fleet of craft. Enormous amounts of time and energy have created the Club and members expect these traditions and values to be respected. As a member you will be expected to help keep the Club operational by becoming involved with maintenance of boats, trailer, oars, launching area, boat shed, Club House as well as fund raising activities and regatta duties.

The Port Macquarie Rowing Club Constitution, Code of Conduct and Child Protection Policy form the binding code of conduct for all members of the Port Macquarie Rowing Club.

CURRENT MEMBERS are advised that the payment of fees is due by 31 July 2006.

Members may elect to pay by two installments with the 1st payment to be ½ of the full membership fee plus the full value of insurance of \$5.00/person payable by 31 July 2006 and the 2nd payment to be the remaining ½ of the full membership fee payable by 31 October 2006.

NEW MEMBERS joining after 1 July 2006 are expected to pay a pro-rata payment for the remaining part of the year.

NOTICE FOR TRAINEE NOVICE ROWERS

Membership is restricted to those that:

- Are 14yrs of age and over or in Year 8 and above at secondary school
- Can swim 100m in rowing attire

Trainee Programs will be offered at the discretion of the Club Committee.

All new trainee rowers will be expected to attend an information session. The Trainee Program will run over six sessions and will cost \$100. This fee is payable at the first of the six sessions. Following completion of the six sessions, consultation with the trainee, coach and Director of Coaching will take place and the next stage of support mutually determined.

Trainees who wish to continue rowing, will be required to pay full Club membership and the Trainee Program fee will be deducted off the full membership fee. This means that "at the end of the day" only the cost of the membership fee is actually paid.

REGATTA FEES

To compete in any NSW Rowing Regattas, including the Port Macquarie Regatta, members need to make their own arrangements to join the NSW Rowing Association and to pay the applicable Association Fee.
